Hello Mr. Ban Ki-moon,

By my letter of 3 August 2012 I have informed you and all Heads of State of the Nations and States participating in the United Nations of my sovereignty and claims.

Please also inform all Heads of State of the Nations and States participating in the United Nations of the following:

As attached you can find the Declaration of Sovereignty and Independence of the State of the iLusilands as well as an example of the passport as it will be used by any person participating in the State of the iLusilands. I expect you, your servants, employees and subjects to allow any bearer of such a document to pass freely without let or hindrance, and afford the bearer every assistance and protection which may be necessary.

For the record and to avoid misunderstandings, I note that it is your responsibility to inform the employees in your organization, including and among others the Provincial States, Municipalities, Police & Justice, the Tax and other local authorities or semi-governments, as well.

I trust that I have informed you in a proper manner, that you understand all I have stated above and that we can live in peace amongst each other.
